



- Survey quality and plans have been shared.
- GIS work currently with DE to produce final working project.
- Will not be published in the public domain
- Further questions as to purpose of the map.
- NSHC asked to provide guidance on use of the map



NSHC Conclusion 97 – Applicability of Alternative Survey Techniques

- CSB: Lack of clarity at the international level
- Drones: Navigational aid position fixing and shallow water bathymetry.
- Unmanned Vessels: Concentration on navigation often to detriment of survey oversight and output.




North Sea Shipping Group
