Key point: interoperability between EMODnet and the IHO standards








### **BATHYMETRY**

- 33000 DTM tiles downloaded yearly by a large range of users
- 15 European HOs and more than 26 research institutes involved
- New World Base Layer (EBWBL) service: a worldwide coverage with GEBCO and EMODnet Bathymetry data
- EMODnet Open Conference (June 2021): more need for qualified and standardized marine data.
- The IHO DCDB harvest the EMODnet data portal

- Necessity to develop cooperation between EU MS for interoperability of data
- Some data still to be produced






European Directive 2019/1024 of 20 June 2019 on Open Data and the re-use of Public Sector Information

- High Value Dataset (HVD)
- Thematic categories listed in the directive (Geospatial, Earth observation & environment, meteorological, ...)
- Potential impact on resources of EU national hydrographic offices
- European Commission recently adopted an implementing act focused on high-value datasets on 21 December 2022.
