IHO Membership

- IHO membership stands at 98. Panama indicated the strong intention to accede. Bolivia came in with questions.
- Unfortunately, Serbia and Syria remain suspended from Member States rights. Lebanon about to join the list.

 Recommendation: NSHC is invited to further assist the Secretariat in promotion of membership to those States not yet IHO Member States.

6th IHO Council (October 2022)

- The C-6 discussed, endorsed and finally forwarded 7 (out of 15) Proposals including the triennial Work Programme and Budget Estimates for 2024 2026.
- Council has become the main topical contributor to Assembly.
- Thanks to NSHC members for proactive and relevant support on Council issues but even so for participation on various Working Groups & Project Teams!




IHO's Strategic goals as core of the Work Programme 2020 - 2026

Goal 1: Evolving the hydrographic support for safety and efficiency of maritime navigation, undergoing profound transformation.

Goal 2: Increasing the use of hydrographic data for the benefit of society.

Goal 3: Participating actively in international initiatives related to the knowledge and the sustainable use of the Ocean.



Most relevant themes related to Goal 1: Support for safety and efficiency of maritime navigation

- Revision of MSC.232(82) ECDIS Performance Standards forces IHO / HO's to deliver.
- Future production of S-101 ENCs in conjunction with S-57 maintenance/production. (to be reported to IMO via IHO Sec.)
- Future production and provision of amending S-1xx products. (to be reported to IMO via IHO Sec.)



Most relevant themes related to Goal 2: Increasing the use of hydrographic data

Observations:

- Uptake of blue economy along all coasts fish farming, sea weed etc.
- Increased request for deep ocean bathymetry for exploitation, renewable energy production, cable, pipelines, deep water warfare etc.
- Private enterprises and digital philanthropists endeavored ocean bathymetry as an area to receive public attention.
- Revitalization of the GEBCO programme with SeaBed2030 project and Map the Gaps as a booster.

International Hydrographic Review (IHR)

- IHR will issue a jubilee edition to celebrate its centenary. Paper version will be distributed at Assembly kindly produced and sponsored by Germany.

- End of January for the May Edition
- End of July for the November Edition
- NSHC Members are invited to submit papers for publication in the IHR.



Most relevant themes related to Goal 3: Participating actively in international ocean initiatives

- First active participation on UN Oceans Conference Lisbon
- Regional activities: Europe collaboration with EMODNET, Digital Twin of the Ocean
- Consultations with global ocean observation programs such as ARGO and Mercator Ocean

Forthcoming 3rd IHO Assembly 2023, established and new Council (C-7 to C-9) after

- Because of the pandemic pause and generation change, Assembly will be a completely new experience for many delegation members.
- Discussions are expected for all together fifteen Proposals.
- Side Event: Empower Women in Hydrography NSHC kindly request to report in advance.
- Thematic session as a new element.
- US dispatches a vessel and provides science on a sphere as central element of the chart exhibition.
