Dear SAIHC Colleagues,

SAIHC17 Postponement Update & Meeting Dates

Following positive discussions with Mauritius (Vice Chair) and South Africa (ICCWG Chair) on 16th June 2020, it has been agreed that the SAIHC17 plenary should be postponed until January 2021, subject to the Mauritian Government's approval to host the conference.

Accordingly, the following program is proposed for consideration:

- A video tele conference (VTC) on 7th September 2020 to include an introduction by the SAIHC Chair and an overview by IHO Secretariat. Working group meetings will take place on completion by VTC, led by their respective Chairs, ICCWG (South Africa), MSDIWG (UK).
- The SAIHC17 plenary meeting 3-day conference, hosted by Mauritius, has been proposed to take place either during the week commencing 18th or 25th January 2021.
- The plenary meeting will be preceded by the SAIHC Seminar on Raising Awareness of Hydrography.

Further details regarding the VTC will forwarded in due course.

Once approval, dates and venue have been confirmed for the plenary conference, a formal invitation will be issued, together with the logistics information, a registration form and a draft agenda. In the meantime, may I encourage you to consider the actions from SAIHC16 and ICCWG8, detailed at Annex A and B respectively, and to provide any updates to the SAIHC secretary, Ashley.Parker@ukho.gov.uk and International.Relations@ukho.gov.uk.

Finally, I would to thank you again for your efforts in support of SAIHC and wish you and your families and colleagues all the very best as we look to overcome the effects of COVID-19 and return to some sort of normality.
