#### **TOP ACHIEVEMENTS DURING THE YEAR**


## **Bathymetric and hydrographic surveys**

Bathymetric surveys in the ports of Moroni (Grande-Comore) and Mutsamudu (Anjouan)

o **For the port of Moroni**: carried out in the port basin and for the installation of new buoys for gas and bulk cement (powder) vessels

 For the port of Mutsamudu: carried out following the dredging of the port

 For the port of Moheli: Barometric and hydrographic surveys were carried out on the island of Moheli for the construction of a new deep-water port.

# **Navigation aids**

• A study on navigation aids was carried out in order to update them.



# **Training**

 The National Agency for Maritime Affairs (ANAM) had made a request for BS Hydro training to Shom. Two (2) candidates were selected. They are currently in training in Brest until August 2024

- The main challenge is the establishment of the National Hydrographic Committee (CHN) which must bring together several entities
