Chiuta as well as the Shire River;

- Publicise notices to mariners and sailing direction
- First hydrographic surveys were conducted in 1950s;
- 40% of Lake Malawi has been surveyed





ACHIEVEMENTS DURING THE YEAR

SIGNINNG OF MOU - MALAWI & UKHO

The bilateral meeting took place in Taunton, UK in June 2024

- MOU was signed to build a strong joint partnership in Hydrography between Malawi and United Kingdom Hydrographic office through;
 - Exchange programme for capacity building;
 - Sharing general technical advice on development of hydrography, nautical cartography and spatial data infrastructure









ACHIEVEMENTS DURING THE YEAR

- The survey was organized by Syracuse University USA
- The data will be used to determine the position and rate of motion of faults below lake Malawi;
- The data will be used to better understand earthquake hazard to communities in the rift valley
- Area of Sedimentation were discovered







ACHIEVEMENTS DURING THE YEAR
