 - a. <u>Pre-meeting 4 February 2025 by VTC</u>

Given the large number of Agenda items to be discussed at SWPHC22, a virtual pre-meeting is planned for **4 February 2025 scheduled for 1100 to 1500 (Sydney time UTC + 11)**. The meeting invitation and virtual link will be emailed to all registered SWPHC22 attendees on 28 January 2025. Please ensure you have registered for the SWPHC meeting to receive the virtual meeting link.

Both the Capacity Building Workshop and the SWPHC22 Meeting will be held at the Palau Royal Resort (<u>Palau Royal Resort | Palau Luxury Resorts | Hotel Palau</u>). A special rate has been secured for bookings up to 28 December 2024 please quote code "BMT". Invited participants under the IHO Capacity Building Program are **not** required to make any hotel reservations.

e. <u>Registration</u>

Those attending the meeting in person are requested to register as soon as possible. Face to face registrations close on 10 February 2025, whilst virtual attendees have until 26 February 2025. In person attendance is capped at 65 attendees.

Once you are a member of the SWPHC portal site, you will be able to register for the SWPHC 22 meeting, and access meeting documents as they are uploaded.
