PB updated group on IHO Document C17, guidance for hydrographic offices, currently out with hydrographic offices for final votes on adopting document. https://iho.int/uploads/user/pubs/Drafts/C-17%20Ed%203.0.0 October%202023 Final.pdf. Update from David Crossman on IIC activity in the region over the last few months. SPC contracted to gather LiDAR data for Tonga, Marshall Islands, Samoa and Vanuatu a few years ago. Part of this was delivery of training to these nations and led to development of further training course which has since been delivered to many organisations across the region. Niue also asked IIC to develop spatial data infrastructure to help them manage their data holdings (EIMS – Environmental Information Management System). Request from RG for a demo of the Niue EIMS Spatial Data Infrastructure when the portal is ready. Kiribati Outer Islands Infrastructure Project to gather LiDAR Data for Kiribati Outer Islands. Ongoing project to gather data and build on outer islands project to the main island of Tarawa. Further training opportunities in S58B Training Programme. Many countries now using IIC for capacity building training. Philippines running course for 10-13 students, also looking into similar course for Vietnam.
