Review and agreement of minutes and actions arising

HP opened the meeting.

Minutes from the 12th meeting of the SWPHC MSDI WG accepted as true and correct, with one typo adjustment.

Actions were reviewed, updated, and closed accordingly. The following noteworthy actions received attention:

Invite non-participating members to WG.

- HP encouraged members to ask colleagues or other organisations to join the working group and ways to make the group more accessible for everyone.
- AM asked what would be expected of new members, HP explained that WG is to learn about MSDI and contribute to working group activities.
- BJ asked whether this would be targeted at recruiting new members from IHO Member states or wider? Suggested the SWPHC2 I meeting (February 2024) would be best place to recruit other IHO member states.
- PB highlighted that IHO can be an insular community, participation from wider community is beneficial to facilitate wider understanding. Discussion around whether members need to be IHO member states. DA confirmed there is already precedent in TORs to include Expert Contributors from outside traditional Hydrographic Offices.

• TT – Suggested that IHO secretariat representative may be able to offer support on how different organisations and roles fit into IHO working groups.

ACTION: HP/DM to contact IHO secretariat to determine membership status of working groups, are there already classifications for different working group members?

Also clarify whether member from non-IHO organisation can be nominated for chair/vice chair of IHO working groups.

Presentation from Trevor Taylor on the activities of the Open Geospatial Consortium (OGC). Overview of pilot projects related to connecting the land and sea, challenges working with data covering both marine and terrestrial domain.

PB highlighted how OGC Pilot Projects linked to IGIF Strategic Pathways, challenges with connecting land and sea highlight importance of Governance, data, partnerships and other strategic pathways.

- BJ feedback that presentation from Palu at the Seabed 2030 SaWPaC conference was well received and generated some interest from the conference attendees.
- BJ also shared with Crowd Sourced Bathymetry Working Group and received good feedback and interest from attendees.
- BJ visited Ocean Science Conference in Fiji, lots of presentations from multiple data scientists, one issue not addressed was interoperability, would have been a good opportunity to share data sharing document and MSDI Working Group activities.


Further progress on SWPHC Workplan Action No 19: Adoption and Implementation of UNGGIM IGIF-H.

AM presented summary of research and understanding of IGIF Strategic Pathway 5 – Innovation.

Points to highlight: Discussion: Interesting that "Process Improvement" is included under the "Innovation" pathway, discussion around how interlinked the pathways are and that process improvement may come up in another pathway. Half Yearly Review of Working Group Terms of Reference, working group operating procedures and work Review of plan for the next 6 months, leading up to SWPHC2 I. Terms of Reference Postponed to next working group meeting. and Working Group **Practice AOB** PB Announced that they will be stepping away from the working group as vice chair due to new job role. Working group asked for nominations for a new vice chair. AM asked whether working group has a description of roles and duties for the vice chair role? If not there is a template from AusSeabed that could be added to Terms of Reference for the MSDI WG. AusSeabed Terms of Reference for an example can be found here - GA Word Doc (ausseabed.gov.au) BJ expressed interest in taking on vice chair position. Discussion around whether this was possible under IHO guidance. **ACTION:** HP to check with IHO secretariat whether Vice Chair needs to be from member state and whether working group can be extended to other organisations outside member states. HP asked for volunteers to present on further IGIF Strategic Pathways. BJ volunteered to present on Strategic Pathway 7 – Partnerships at next MSDI WG Meeting. Strategic Pathway 6 – Standards – TO BE CONFIRMED Working Group aim to have series of short videos on each Strategic Pathway in time for the next SWPHC Meeting in February 2024. **ACTION:** Could all members consider whether they would be prepared to research one of the remaining IGIF strategic pathways and present their findings back to the group.
