ACTIVITY 2.2 – Gather feedback on the value and need for the implementation and adoption of IGIF.

Previous discussions at this working group have identified gaps in knowledge about what support is required in the region for the implementation and adoption of IGIF. This working group activity aims to gather feedback about what is already happening and what support may be required from the MSDI WG, SWPHC and IHO to support the region with this goal.

Discussion about what support the working group can provide on the adoption and implementation of IGIF. In previous meetings the working group members have questioned what support is available, what activities are already ongoing for the implementation of IGIF.

BJ suggested that many countries (E.g. Kiribati, Cook Islands) have already made progress towards implementation of IGIF and developing a national MSDI, however, as a region we do not have a record of these developments on a national level.

SC suggested that some of this information may be found in the national reports that are submitted to the SWPHC on an annual basis.

ACTION: Working Group members to review national reports from specific countries to research and extract information on implementation of IGIF. Capture the information that has already been shared in one place so that we can identify gaps in knowledge that can be investigated with the relevant points of contact in the national organisations.
