1. Review and agreement of minutes and actions arising	Minutes from the 6 th Meeting of the SWPHC MSDI WG accepted as true and correct. Actions were reviewed, updated, and closed accordingly.
2. Progress our SWPHC Work Plan action - "Data Value Propositions"	
2.a. Update on progress	<p>HP, PB, and TM participated in a virtual workshop to further develop the Data Value Propositions document on 24/25 August 2022. Significant progress was made including mapping of the propositions to the UN Sustainability goals which were grouped into four themes;</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Food Security 2. Education and Capacity Development 3. Safety 4. Sustainability <p>With an additional category denoting "Public release sovereignty" added later.</p> <p>PB requested a review of the paragraph she drafted on "Data Release", noting the unique position Hydrographic Offices in balancing open data with national security concerns.</p> <p>RG noted that NZHO openly release all their hydrographic survey data</p> <p>HP noted that the UKHO can't release some data, and some is commercially available, but all data is findable via its metadata.</p>

	<p>PB suggested a good median point between 100% open sharing or not at all would be to at least openly share the metadata of all data held.</p> <p>RG asked and PS confirmed that the focus of the data value propositions was on data held by Hydrographic Offices.</p> <p>DA questioned if there was consideration in the DVP of determining jurisdictions and regulatory zones and areas. The DVP was amended live with that addition.</p> <p>PS summarised this agenda item, closing with a request for all members to review the document one last time before we consider it done.</p> <p>ACTION ALL: Review DVP document for grammatical consistency, any additional propositions, applicability to UN sustainability goals, and content of “data release” section. DUE 4 Nov 2022.</p>
<p>2.b. Revisit our “What Good Looks Like” statements</p>	<p>HP referred to the working groups MIRO board and reviewed our items on what we all think “good” looks like. In summary, Short, concise, bullet pointed propositions, with graphics and icons.</p> <p>HP and PB agreed to touch up the document with the UN supplied icons/graphics for the sustainability goals, and seek assistance from internal graphic design teams.</p> <p>SC suggested cross-checking our work with that of the S100 working group and also the UN GGIM Marine Domain working group material.</p>
<p>2.c. Discuss next steps and agree actions</p>	<p>Next steps and actions were agreed as noted above.</p>
<p>3. Other Business</p>	<p>RG informed the group of an upcoming Symposium in November; the Oceania Geospatial Symposium https://www.oceania-geospatial.com/ to be held in Noumea.</p> <p>JS informed the group that unfortunately this Symposium coincides with a 20 year long running OSGeo Conference in Fiji; the Pacific Geospatial Conference 2022 https://osgeo-oceania.org/pacific-geospatial-conference/</p> <p>DC noted this is unfortunate as for most countries, it would be the same person that would attend both. Not possible under the current arrangement.</p> <p>The group discussed opportunities to attend these conferences and advertise the existence of this working group. Both DC and JS are planning on attending the OSGeo PGC, and JS agreed to promote this WG at the conference.</p> <p>ACTION JS/PB: To write a few sentences about the SWPHC MSDI working group for information at the OSGeo PGC.</p>
