PASSPORTS, VISAS

AIRPORT TRANSPORT

There are no public buses connecting the airport with Wollongong and taxis are very expensive. Airport transfers are offered by a Wollongong company (\$75.00 one way) and take about 1.5 hours from Sydney Airport (www.leisurecoastlimousine.com.au/airport-transfers/)

There is an airport train which goes to Wollongong but you need to change train at Wolli Creek station (wait for the southbound train). To find the station at the airport, which is below the terminals, follow the railway signs. The train also connects the International Terminal with Sydney (if you want to spend the weekend up there). From Sydney you have frequent trains to Wollongong (see www.transportnsw.info/). Self drive rental cars are available at Sydney Airport and in the city (Avis, Budget, Hertz etc)..

WOLLONGONG FREE SHUTTLE

A free Wollongong Shuttle bus runs in both directions on a loop connecting Wollongong Station, CBD, University and Boat Harbour. There is a bus stop (Stop 8) location adjacent to the Novotel offering a convenient option for those not staying at the Novotel.
