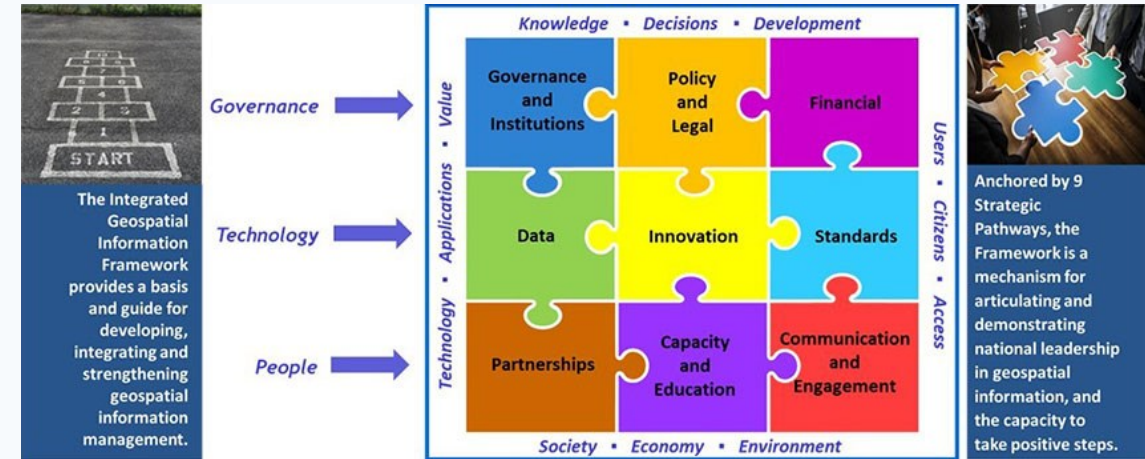

Where we are now

- Kiribati Marine Spatial Planning Coordinating Committee (KMSPCC) sits with MFMRD (Chair and Secretariat):
 - Hydrographic and Geospatial Data Management Committees as sub-committees
 - Building on previous knowledge of IGIF to continue refining country action plan/work plan
 - Data management, policies, access, etc.
 - Looking for advice from SPC and industry partners in developing physical infrastructure
 - Workshop with IUCN BIOSCAPE (through MFMRD) – Marine Spatial Planning
 - 11th of March workshop to be facilitated NZ and NIWA (focusing on the restructuring of the PIPA in terms of MSP).
 - Kiribati is now part of the SWPHC MSDI WG
