

Assembly Decision 21: tasked the Council to discuss the request from the SWPHC for the provision of mechanisms to ensure greater inclusion and participation of all Member States at IHO meetings, in particular the IHO Assembly and come up with solutions as soon as possible.

The Council agreed to prepare an IHO Resolution on Guidelines for Making IHO Events More Inclusive, endorsed the principle of considering an initial proposal for a IHO Resolution Guidelines for Making IHO Events More Inclusive ... and then tasked an ad hoc drafting group (respectively IRCC) to conduct a survey on behalf of the Council to assess ... different modalities (in-person, in-person with live streaming, hybrid, or full VTC).





Recommendations and Invitations for the Commission's Consideration

a. Committees are requested to respond to IHO CLs in a timely manner, particularly during Phase 1 implementation of S-100.

b. Confirm the role of New Zealand as regional S-100 coordinator in accordance with the WEND-100 Principles and S-1xx Implementation Guidelines.

c. Participate in the Project Team on Fund Generation of IHO' Project Initiatives under the IRCC (CL 42/2023).

d. Support the continuation of the EWH project through financial and / or in-kind support.and to provide proposals via the specific webpage (<u>https://iho.int/en/basic-cbsc-ewh</u>).

e. Provide the IRCC Chair with an update regarding the measurement of those SPI of regional interest allocated to IRCC.

f. Conduct a survey within Commission on hosting and attending meetings in the four different modalities (in-person, in-person with live streaming, hybrid, or full VTC).

- g. Provide contributions to the IHO e-Learning Center at KHOA
- h. Ensure the timely provision of MSI through NAV and MET Area Coordinators.
- *i. Make data freely available for inclusion in the DCDB and the widest possible use, in accordance with IHO Resolution 1/2017.*

j. Review entries in the IHO Yearbook and C-55 to provide the IHO Secretariat with the appropriate updates or to report no change (CL 20/2019).

k. Participate in the GEBCO week 2024 to be held in Nadi, Fiji.

I. Initiate the preparation of inputs for the review of the IHO Strategic Plan (C7/37 refers) and thanks SWPHC Members (FR, GB, NZ and US) for their involvement in the Correspondence Group of the Council.
