


## The Ocean Decade in Canada

- Canada, represented by the Minister of Fisheries, Oceans and the Canadian Coast Guard, is a member of the Ocean Decade Alliance.
- The Canadian Ocean Community is well positioned to lead by example and make unique contributions, including: Indigenous knowledge, Arctic, Youth/early career ocean professionals, Ocean Literacy, Gender equity, Climate change
- Engagement in the Ocean Decade aligns with Canada's plans to advance its Blue Economy Strategy, the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development, and other international commitments.
- Engagement in the Ocean Decade strengthens science networks, creates new opportunities for innovative partnerships and collaboration, leverages a global platform to showcase science and innovation.

A Canadian National Decade Committee draws from the collective leadership of the Canadian Ocean Community to build a strong Canadian contribution




# Supporting the Ocean Decade (2018-2022)

Actions led by Fisheries and Oceans Canada (DFO)



Canada is a strong supporter of the Ocean Decade, DFO is the focal point in Canada.



The United Nations Decade of Ocean Science for Sustainable Development 2021-2030 ("Ocean Decade") is an innovative. global effort to expand partnerships to support effective science, ocean management, and sustainable development.

#### **Governance Highlights**

Established a dedicated Ocean Decade Office at DFO

Provided financial support to the Canadian Node of the Ocean Decade Early Career Ocean Professionals (ECOPs) Programme

Canada joined the Ocean Decade Alliance a global network of leaders to inspire and stimulate actions

Established Canada's National Ocean Decade Committee. including a Community of Champions led by 7 leaders to engage and foster participation

#### Thematic Highlights

Provided support to a series of Indigenous-led projects

Provided financial support to ArcticNet to initiate new Arctic research projects

With the Natural Sciences and Engineering Research Council of Canada (NSERC), established an Award Program for doctoral candidates from underrepresented groups in ocean science

Launched 12 initiatives to advance gender equity, diversity and inclusion with 10 Canadian and international partners

Advanced 9 Youth and Early Career Ocean Pofessionals (ECOPs) initiatives with 13 Canadian and international partners

#### **Engagement Highlights**

700 participants attended two virtual events to inform Canada's Blueprint for the Ocean Decade

Provided financial support to IOC-UNESCO for the global coordination function

Provided a total of \$8.4M in financial support to 53 partners With 63 Canadian and international organizations, co-hosted 19 Ocean Decade events and partnered on 37 different projects, from which 23 received formal endorsement from the Intergovernmental Oceanographic Commission (IOC) of UNESCO


