1. USCHC47 Announcement

Please accept this invitation to join the United States-Canada Hydrographic Commission (USCHC)-47 meeting. The in-person meeting will take place on May 30-31 at the Northwest Atlantic Fisheries Centre, scheduled to begin the afternoon of May 30 after the conclusion of the U.S. Hydrographic Conference. For planning purposes, the USCHC47 meeting will be held tentatively from 14h30 - 17h30 Newfoundland Daylight Time (GMT-2.5) on May 30 and from 08h30 to 16h30 on Friday March 31. The meeting room will be confirmed shortly.

Virtual participation is planned for those members wishing to join but otherwise unable to travel.

2. Hotel and Visa

Attendees are invited to make their own travel and hotel arrangements at their earliest convenience. A special group rate has been negotiated for both CHC and USCHC attendees at the Delta Hotel St. John's Conference Centre located at 130 New Gower St., St. John's, NL, A1C 6K4.

The local airport is the St. John's International Airport (stjohnsairport.com).

Non-Canadian citizens travelling to Canada should check for any <u>entry requirements</u> - the Immigration, Refugee, and Citizenship Canada (IRCC) website is a good place to start. Citizens of the USA and most European countries are not required to have a visa per the linked IRCC website. Some travelers, if coming from a visa-exempt country, may require an <u>Electronic Travel</u> <u>Authorization</u>. US Citizens are exempt from this requirement, but please still verify your specific requirements using the two websites linked above.

3. CHC 2024

If you are planning to attend the CHC 2024, all information regarding the Conference (accommodations, registration, transportation, and other logistics) can be found at the Canadian Hydrographic Association https://example.com/homepage.
