






Committee Role

- Facilitate cooperation in international engagement in S-100 relevant international bodies and provide a venue for evaluation of international work and its impact on Canada.







Data Dissemination 1/2

Waterway Zone Concept

- A proposed solution to the gap that will be created as the world shifts away from paper charts to user defined charts.
- Instead of referring to traditional chart numbers to relate information to a geographic location, geospatially defined areas (waterways) will be used.


Authoritative data

- Goal: Create/provide authoritative S-100 data through regulation and validation.
- Impacts of the WEND Principles on data coverage are considered.

Data Dissemination 2/2

Maritime Connectivity Platform (MCP)/SECOM

- Development and implementation of standards and secure means of communication to enable infrastructure for seamless electronic information exchange among maritime stakeholders.
- Goal: Provision of cybersecure infrastructure for maritime information exchange.
- Ongoing tests and trial implementations
 - Successful SECOM trials to disseminate S-124 test data in a lab environment.
 - Lessons from these trials will be used to create additional services.
