# **Technical Conference 22\_2 Invitation and Agenda**



Once logged in you will need to self-enrol on to the conference, you will then see the following view, click on View on the Seminar Links tile (circled)






This will then display the seminars that you can 'sign-up' for (there are 3 in total)
