Regarding the NAVTEX services areas of Ukraine, Western part of the Crimean Peninsula, NAVTEX service area of Odessa, and the Sea of Azov and Kerch Strait, NAVTEX service area of Berdiansk, the Russian Federation sends his messages to the NAVAREA III Coordinator as “MSI for transfer”, to be transmitted by Ukraine by his appropriate NAVTEX stations, Odessa or Berdiansk.
