NAVAREA ## OPERATIONS AND UPDATES

International Hydrographic Organization

Operational Issues

- NAVTEX Service
 - US Stations down for approx. 12,450 hours
 - Curacao regained operational status
- Space Operations
 - 626 Pieces of source concerning space operations, over an 100%

Changes in National Coordinator Contact Information and IRCC Strategic Performance Indicator (SPI) for MSI capacity

- Contact Information
 - New point of contact for numerous countries, please see the full report.
 - IRCC SPI changes:
 - Costa Rica had successful communications
 - Bahamas, Barbados, Grenada, Nicaragua, and Saint Lucia did not have successful communications

Changes to the GMDSS Master Plan

- *EGC*
 - NAVAREA IV/XII added its SafetyCast scheduled broadcast times
- NAVTEX
 - Ecuador remains temporarily suspended

Vital or Urgent Navigational Warnings Issued

- 2 Urgent navigational warnings
- All warnings concerned icebergs outside the limit of known ice. These urgent warnings self-cancelled in 72 hours in consultation with the North American Ice Service



FUTURE NAVAREA OPERATIONS

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S-124 Development

- NAVAREA IV/XII is aiming to have S-124 Navigational Warning datasets available in 2026.
- NAVAREA IV/XII's operational database has been altered to contain textual data and GML data/
- The intention is to create S-124 datasets for administrations that rely on NAVAREA IV/XII to promulgate S-53 warnings on their behalf. Work continues with National Coordinators on S-124 through the MACHC MSI WG.
- NAVAREA IV/XII plans to remain active in the work of the S-124 PT in the future.

Other Future NAVAREA Initiatives

- NAVAREA IV/XII continues to remain active in MSI
 Capacity Building. There is a potential for two
 additional course to take place in 2024, in addition
 to the courses in Oman and Türkiye this year.
- Intend on participating with the Space Activity
 Advisory Group on operational issues from space
 operations and space weather.
