





S-124 development

Based on current progress, NAVAREA X is unlikely to declare operational S-124 services by 1 January 2026.

Other future NAVAREA initiatives

- Staying abreast of developments in one coastal state to deploy NAVTEX.
- Further discussions are required to determine the future of regional MSI training courses (especially due to funding concerns) and whether opportunities to utilise a different delivery model could improve the ability to hold these capacity building activities within NAVAREA X and XIV.
