Subject: Data Quality Working Group Meeting 8; Sydney or Wollongong, Australia 26–28 March

2014

Dear Working Group Member,

- 1. The 8th meeting of the Data Quality Working Group Meeting (DQWG-8) will be held on 26-28 March 2014 and will join with the next TSMAD and DIPWG meetings which are scheduled from 31 March to 4 April 2014 in Sydney or Wollongong, Australia. The actual venue should soon be confirmed and logistical information and a registration form will then be published on the IHO website (http://www.iho.int/mtg_docs/com_wg/DQWG/DQWG8/DQWG8.htm). Any meeting documents will also be posted on that web page when they are ready.
- 2. The reason why DQWG-8 will be co-located with TSMAD and DIPWG is because by then we will have finalised the main work element of developing the revised portrayal for data quality. The HICUP sub group established during DQWG-7 is to report its findings to the full DQWG who, once agreed, will present this to the TSMAD on the following week, effectively completing this element of our work.
- 3. Given that this is the fundamental deliverable of the DQWG I hope that as many DQWG members as possible can attend so that the output of the HICUP group can be carefully scrutinised and agreed prior to finally being delivered.
- 4. I am very conscious that travel budgets are remaining very tight but would appreciate your attendance at the proposed meeting so that we can finalise this vital stage in the work of the DQWG. If suitably experienced participants, such as yourself, are unable to attend then the output of the DQWG is likely to be compromised, with a consequential effect on the overall HSSC work program, and in particular, work on S-100.
- 5. Once submitted to TSMAD the DQWG deliverable will form an element of the S-100 demonstrator being developed.
- 6. Although not confirmed, I anticipate that the DQWG will need to meet once more, probably in June or July 2015 to conclude our work.
- 7. A draft agenda for DQWG-8 is attached at Annex A.

8. I greatly appreciate your continued efforts on this work topic and look forward to working with you between now and March 2014 and then meeting you in Australia.
