

ABLOS31 logistics information

1. Everyone attending the meeting must complete the registration form at [IHO Online Registration](#).
2. Niterói is located in the Rio de Janeiro city metropolitan area. It is served by two airports: Tom Jobim-Galeão International Airport (GIG) and Santos Dumont National Airport (SDU). Niterói is ideally about half an hour driving from both airports, but times vary depending on the traffic at Rio-Niterói bridge.
3. There are several types of accommodation close to the meeting venue. Please feel free to choose one that fits better your taste. However, keep in mind that a **daily transfer service by van** will be provided by DHN between H Niterói Hotel (R. Dr. Paulo Alves, 14 - Ingá, Niterói – RJ) and the meeting venue.
4. Temperature during October in Niterói ranges between 20° to 28°C with often clear sky, but rain may also occur. The average wind speed is usually gentle breeze, but more windy periods may also arise.
5. Electrical sockets (outlets) in Brazil are the "Type N". Electricity voltage in the accommodation and meeting area is 110 V, 60Hz.
