IMO NCSR 8/13/1 - REPORT ON MONITORING OF ECDIS ISSUES BY IHO

International Hydrographic Organization

- Informed on the availability of S-67 Mariners' Guide to Accuracy of Depth Information in ENC & Guidance document "Information on ENC Generalization, Over-Scaling and Safety Checking Functions in ECDIS".
- Informed on the S-100 implementation
- Informed that IHO will commit to, in preparation for NCSR 9 and to assist the revision process, submit draft amendments for both resolution MSC.232(82) and MSC.1/Circ.1503/Rev.1 to NCSR 9 for consideration by the Sub-Committee.



OUTCOME OF NCSR-8

- The Sub-Committee noted the information provided and Canada supporting the recommendations made by IHO.
- Invited interested Member States and international organizations to contribute to the work of IHO in the preparation of amendments to resolution MSC.232(82) and MSC.1/Circ.1503/Rev.1.13.8.
- A view was expressed (France) indicating support for the implementation of the IHO's S-100 Universal Hydrographic Data Model and the recognition of S-101 Electronic Navigational Charts (ENC) for ECDIS, emphasizing also the need to align the work schedule of the Organization with that of IHO to ensure implementation of S-100 product specifications by 2024, with a transitional phase up to 2030.
