#### **KEY OUTCOMES OF NCSR 10**

International Hydrographic Organization

- 1. Status of Iridium SafetyCast Manual went from 'interim' to in full force as a live manual. Mainly relevant to IRCC but does highlight the growing number of recognized satellite providers and thus is a consideration for S-124.
- 2. Joint MSI Manual to be submitted to MSC 108 for endorsement. Mainly relevant to IRCC but does require consideration by S-124 PT.



#### **KEY OUTCOMES OF NCSR 10**

International Hydrographic Organization 3. In response to paper NCSR 10/21/8, IHO were universally thanked for their update and future updates were requested. NCSR 10 requested that going forward, that IHO provide more detail with regard to the progress of individual Product Specifications against the S-100 implementation roadmap in future updates.

### KEY OUTCOMES OF NCSR 10

- It should be noted that NCSR 10 endorsed an amendment to MSC.530(106) ECDIS Performance Standards to include the exchange of route plans from ship to shore and from shore to ship.
- The amendment of ECDIS Performance Standards also includes a standard for secure communication between ship and shore, IEC SECOM (63173-2). This would be relevant also for distribution of other applicable S-100 products.
- The inclusion of route exchange follow the same transition plan as S-100 ECDIS. Voluntary 1 Jan 2026 and mandatory for new systems from 1 Jan 2029.
- To be approved by MSC 108 in April/May 2024.





## KEY OUTCOMES OF MSC 107 (NOTE MEETING HAS NOT YET FINISHED)

#### Summary of outcome from presentation of paper MSC 107/15/2:

- IHO noted that this topic was being presented simultaneously to HSSC and suggested that no specific action be taken at this time;
- Interventions were made by Liberia, France, Bahamas, Argentina, Netherlands, Malta and Panama; all of these countries supported the tenant of the paper, and in some cases the specific recommendations;
- France, with general agreement from the other countries noted the particular challenge for those vessels who fall outside the threshold for mandatory ECDIS carriage, or those that otherwise still rely on paper

The IHO's domain expertise was noted and referencing the intervention made by the IHO, the Chair proposed (and received agreement on) the following outcomes:

- IMO continue to liaise closely with IHO on this issue;
- Noted the general support for the concerns raised in the paper;
- No specific action required in relation to the recommendations other than the MSC is kept updated via NCSR as relevant information becomes available.
