

### Introduction / Background

The font style of neat line dimensions in the charting standards INT2(Border, Graduation, Grids and Linear Scale) is shown as *Arial Italics*. However the font style for the neat line dimension is shown as Arial Upright in S4(Regulations of the IHO for International (INT) Charts, INT1(Symbols and Abbreviations Used on paper charts) Edn. 8 of year 2020 and INT3(Use of Symbols and Abbreviations) Edn. 05, 08<sup>th</sup> Dec 2011. To avoid the confusion and to maintain the consistency, the Neat Line dimensions should be of same font in all standard documents S4, INT1, INT2 & INT3



#### **Analysis / Discussion**

Uniform symbology should be shown in all standard documents viz., S-4, INT1, INT2, INT3 and also in the S-100 compliant product specification.

#### Recommendations

Standardization of symbology is recommended in view of migration into to S-100 series of products.

## Conclusion

Charting standards and specification need to be updated to maintain the consistency.
