NCWG 8 Update Correspondence

Dear colleagues,

I am writing to provide you with some update information about NCWG 8 ($15^{th} - 18^{th}$ November 2022 in Wollongong, Australia) and to include some important requests and reminders.

- I am keen to remind you of the opportunity to support NCWG in the important vacant role as our secretary. The requested deadline for submissions of your interest was September 30th, thus far we have only received interest from one volunteer. Please can you consider if your Hydrographic Office would be able to offer a secretary to help us fulfil this important role.
- The deadline for the submission of papers to be raised and discussed with the Working Group was the 27th of September. However, I would still enourage you to supply papers, noting that the chair will need to approve their presentation for discussion with the Working Group at NCWG8.
- The deadline to register for NCWG8 is today, 30th September, you can register as joining in person or virtually. Participants planning for in-person participation that are unable to confirm their attendance before the deadline are invited to inform the host robert.cario@defence.gov.au and the IHO Secretariat yves.guillam@iho.int on their plans to attend and the number of potential participants at the deadline. - Reviewing reports following marine incidents is a standing agenda item for NCWG, where lessons can be learned to amend and improve chart content and, or policy.

- The request to consider the content of S-4 from a machine-readable point of view has been raised and discussed at NCWG. S-4 remains an important and relevant document, describing both how and why features are part of charted information. At 450+ pages, S-4 is a large document and it is not feasible to review and revise the content of the whole document and reach consensus on modified content. However, to move this request forwards, representatives from the OEMs are invited to identify the higher priority topics/features which would support their request if they were redefined.
- I would like to take this opportunity to remind you of the open actions which are currently expected to be delivered by NCWG, please see Annex A for more details.
- Finally, Robert, Alvaro, do you have anything you would like to add prior to us meeting in November?
