Dear colleagues,

**Re: architectural display of S-100 related products**

As confirmed by HSSC, the maintenance of the overarching architecture of S-100 based product specifications belongs to NIPWG.

NIPWG6 discussed a drafted architectural display presentation and provided comments. These comments have been considered and revised version of the presentation was drafted. This version is ready for review now; see Annex and attached pptx.

What was done?

The product specifications have been assigned to a regulated and non-regulated system. The first is under the IMO regulations regime whereas the latter has more flexibility for both data provision and presentation.

Data Quality is applicable to some product specifications but not for all. Same applies for portrayal. The limitation of portrayal instructions to S-101 offers a greater flexibility.

I would appreciate it if you could provide written comments on the presentation **by the 13 March** at the latest. I intend to either incorporate them to the pptx for the HSSC NIPWG report (due date 15 March) or to incorporate it in my presentation to HSSC11.
