S-123 Task Group Updates

- Thirteen (13) task group meetings have been held to date.
- Review of the feedback comments is almost complete.
 - 6 out of 51 pages (12%) left to review with the task group.
- A few proposals are being worked on such as:
 - Remodelling of the radiocommunications complex attribute
 - Remodelling of the GMDSSArea and InmarsatOceanRegionArea features
 - Splitting of the NAVAREA/METAREA feature into two (2) separate features

Development of Edition 2.0.0

- It was mentioned in a previous NIPWG meeting regarding what would be needed for the S-123 Product Specifications to move into Edition 2.0.0:
 1. Datasets Conforming to the Standard for Testing Purposes
 - Check with S-164WG to determine where S-123 datasets fall in their work/timeline
 2. Validation Checks
 - Note S-100WG validation work to integrate into S-123 Edition 2.0.0
 3. Portrayal
 - IIC to plan dedicated sessions to testing portrayal and interoperability to move this aspect forward for the development of S-123 Edition 2.0.0
