- International Hydrographic Organization
- The S-131 1.0.0 Product Specification package was circulated on 24 January. Comments were due by 28 February.
- Comments were received from:
  - Finland
  - France
  - Germany
  - NTOU
- 216 comments in all:
  - Editorial comments (~40%)
  - Comments about issues propagated from the IHO GI Registry (~55%)
  - Revisions to the model (~4%)
- Individual comments are being adjudicated.



## **IHO** RELATIONSHIP OF SPECIFICATION TO REGISTRY

- International Hydrographic Organization
- Feature catalogues are created from the entries in the IHO Geospatial Information Registry.
- Annex C (the PDF of the feature catalogue) is generated from the feature catalogue by software.
- The DCEG feature tables are also generated from the feature catalogue, using functionality provided in the S-100 toolkit.
  - That includes section titles that are names.
  - Only the "encoding instructions" parts of the feature tables are manually edited.
- Information propagates from the GI registry.



#### **IHO** PROPOSED DISPOSITION OF COMMENTS

International Hydrographic Organization

- Correct mis-classifications.
- Identify issues propagated from the content of the GI Registry with a special classification ("RG").
- Editorial comments: Evaluate individual comments and apply results of the evaluations to the Edition 1.0.0 documents.
- Model revisions: Postpone to a future edition.
- Issues propagated from the GI Registry: NIPWG arranges to prepare a spreadsheet or table for discussion with the IHO GI Registry Manager.

#### **IHO PROPOSED NEXT STEPS**

- Correct mis-classifications.
- Apply a new "RG" classification for issues stemming from the GI Registry.
- Adjudicate the editorial comments.
- Discuss the classification/adjudication results with the NIPWG leadership team.
  - NIPWG leadership team to determine whether a further VTC to discuss adjudications is necessary.
- Apply final adjudications to the Product Specification package.
- Final review by the NIPWG leadership team.
