Publication of S-101 Edition 1.1.0

Dear S-101 Project Team Members,

I am very pleased to report that no negative comments were received in respond to S-100 WG Letter 3/2023. Therefore S-101 Edition 1.1.0 has now been published on the IHO website and within the IHO GI Registry. This is an important achievement ahead of the HSSC15 meeting. Although a little behind the original schedule due to various S-100 Edition 5.0.0 dependencies this is a major success.
