Meeting venue

The meeting will be held at **Oceania Brest Centre Hotel**.

Address: 82 rue de Siam, 29200 Brest.

The meeting room is located at the -1 level. Entrance by the « Nautilus » door, just on the left of the hotel entrance.

Hotel Oceania is located in Brest very city centre, with lots of restaurants, pubs and shop within 5 minutes walk.



Transportation to and from airport

There are regular flights from Paris (mainly from Charles de Gaulle airport) to Brest airport. The airport is 10 km from the city centre.

Taxis are available at the airport (about 20 € during day / 30€ at night).

Another option is to take Bus line 20 at the airport door. The bus will lead you to « Portes de Gouesnou » where you can take the Tramway Line A. In takes 20 mn to get to the City Centre. « Liberté » Station is 3 mn walk from the venue.



General information

Brest is located 500 km in the West of Paris and is a major Naval city in France, and is very oriented to the sea (2 marinas, Museum, etc.).

Due to our location at the very western point of France, the climate in Brest is oceanic. In June, the temperature is generally about 20° and the weather rather sunny, but as our local saying goes: « *In Brest, you can experience the four seasons in one single day...* ».

Electric plugs

In France, the plugs are of type E. The voltage is 230 V - 50 Hz.



Currency and credit cards

The currency in France is the Euro. Most credit cards are widely accepted (mainly Visa and Mastercard).

Covid 19
