Change Proposal

This proposal describes a change of attribute name from "purpose" in S-100 Edition 4.0.0 Part 4 to "revisionStatus" in S-100 Edition 5.0.0/5.1.0 Part 17 to indicate the purpose for which the support file has been issued.

S-101 PS Clause 11.4.2 states: "The type of support file is indicated in the "purpose" field of the discovery metadata. Three types: new, replacement and deletion are defined."

S-100 Edition 4.0.0 shows attribute "purpose" in the S100_SupportFileDiscoveryMetadata:
