EMPOWERING WOMEN IN HYDROGRAPHY PROJECT - UK IMPROVING GENDER BALANCE FUND – CALL FOR APPLICATIONS

Reference: Letter from UKHO dated 7 May 2024 – United Kingdom support to the Empowering Women in Hydrography project.

Dear Hydrographer,

- 1. The Letter in reference announced the United Kingdom's support for the IHO Empowering Women in Hydrography Project through a dedicated *Improving Gender Balance Fund*. The fund is available to IHO Member States and other coastal states and will provide financial support for women who are working to advance their careers, including their progression to leadership roles in the hydrographic sector. The aims of the fund are to support:
 - The active participation by women from across the hydrographic community in the work of the IHO (e.g. participation in IRCC, HSSC, IBSC, RHCs', Working Groups or Teams meetings);
 - Development opportunities for women through exposure to wider events organizations or project appointments in order to gain skills and experience;
 - The progression of more women to leadership positions across all IHO organs.
- 2. The following general selection criteria will be used:
 - Proposals must directly support the improvement of gender balance in hydrography.
 - Proposals should include a clear and measurable benefit. This may include how they support the progression of the applicant towards a leadership position or personal developments that will be gained.
 - A broad geographic distribution of applicants will be sought.

Proposals will be assessed by the UK upon receipt while keeping the IHO Secretariat informed, and applicants will be notified via email if their request has been approved.

- 3. The *UK Improving Gender Balance Fund* will provide financial support for travel and accommodation for the participants. Any other associated expenses beyond these will be considered and should be outlined in the applicant's proposal.
- 4. Applicants will be expected to provide a short report on the completion of the activity and this material may be included in broader EWH material to demonstrate the value of the investment.
